

Action plan to mitigate potential areas of corruption in Labour Bureau

Labour Bureau is an apex organization in the field of labour and price statistics. The organization is responsible for providing appropriate data base at the national level for policy formulation, evaluation and research. The main activities of the Bureau involve collection and dissemination of data on various facets of Labour, which form basis for decision making in the Government.

Labour Bureau is not a public dealing office and it makes no bulk purchases. Purchases made by the office relate to routine requirements of office stationery, equipments, sanitation material, etc.

The department, however, proposes to take following measures to mitigate corruption if any in the organizational activities:

- i) Efficiency and transparency in purchases/procurements made by the office are proposed to be brought through extensive use of information technology such as placing tenders documents and awards on Bureau's website.

- ii) Vigilance inspection by the Vigilance Officer of Labour Bureau of the purchases amounting to Rs.2 lakh and more made in the office.
