Training Calendar, 2011

Labour Bureau imparts following training in the field of labour and price statistics to:

- i) Employees of primary units engaged in the filling up of Voluntary/Statutory returns in industrially important places in the Northern region of the Country comprised of Bihar, Delhi, Haryana, Punjab, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu & Kashmir, Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Jharkhand, Chattisgarh and Union Territory of Chandigarh in collaboration with their respective State Governments as well as the Chambers of Commerce.
- ii) State Governments/Central Government Departments and Union Territories Administrations officers/officials engaged in the collection, compilation and submission of labour statistics with a view to improve the quality, consistency and timeliness in the flow of statistical data. The Labour Bureau has so far conducted 48 Central Training Courses at Shimla.
- iii) State Governments officers/officials working as Price Supervisors/Price Collectors under Consumer Price Index Numbers for Industrial Workers. The Labour Bureau has so far conducted 19 Central Training Courses at Shimla.
- iv) Participants of International Statistical Education Centre (ISEC), Kolkata;
- v) Indian Economic Service (IES) and Indian Statistical Service (ISS) officers;
- vi) Statistical Officers from state Governments and Subordinate Statistical Service (SSS) officers (New Recruits) sponsored by NASA;
- vii) Participants from Maharashtra Institute of Labour Studies, Mumbai, Ordnance Factories, Maharashtra and Saurashtra University, Rajkot - Gujarat.
- viii) Officers from State Governments dealing with submission of returns under various Labour Laws as and when requested.
